Enterprise Resource Planning Procurement

CARSON CITY – The State of Nevada’s Office of Project Management is pleased to announce the Silver State Modernization Approach for Resources and Technology in the 21st Century, commonly referred to as SMART 21, Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) procurement. The primary features of the SMART 21 ERP procurement include the modernization of the State’s financial management, human resources management and related IT systems, while replacing our legacy system and offering the benefits and value of a shared computing infrastructure.

The procurement of the SMART 21 ERP system will commence with the issuance of a Request for Proposals (RFP) to identify vendors that have the experience, capabilities, and resources to design, build, and implement the project. The RFP is scheduled to be issued on Friday, August 24, 2018, and posted on the State of Nevada’s electronic procurement system, *NevadaEPro* at: NevadaEPro.com. Prospective vendors must be registered in NevadaEPro.com to receive email notification of its release, ask questions, and submit a proposal. A mandatory bidders conference for registered vendors is scheduled for Monday, September 17, 2018, in Carson City from 10:00 a.m. to noon at the Nevada State Legislature, 401 S. Carson St., Room 1214.

The State of Nevada’s Purchasing Division and Office of Project Management will provide information about the project, the procurement process and will be available to answer questions from registered vendors and interested teams about the procurement.

SMART 21 is one of the most important and most ambitious information technology undertakings in the State of Nevada’s recent history. The multi-phase, multi-year project will harness the benefits of modern information technology and accelerate the pace at which the State of Nevada realizes the value of shared computing infrastructure.
