The State is not liable for the obligations of any local government which joins or uses this or any contract resulting from this Participating Addendum.
- 3.2 <u>REQUISITIONS:</u> All State agencies requisitions over \$5000.00 will be processed by and through the Nevada Purchasing Division and a purchase order issued, as needed, at the

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contracted price(s). Local governments as defined in NRS 332.015 can purchase directly and be billed by vendor.

#### 3.3 ADMINISTRATIVE FEE:

- a. Contractor shall pay a quarterly administrative fee payable to the "State of Nevada Purchasing Division." The administrative fee is one percent (1%) and applies to all Administrative Fee Components (as defined below) received by the Contractor under the contract during the quarter beginning the date of execution of this contract. The term "Administrative Fee Components" is defined as base rental charges and the following optional products: GPS units, satellite radio service, toll device, Personal Affects Insurance (PAI), Personal Effects Coverage (PEC), and any charges for additional roadside assistance purchased by the Traveler, BUT specifically excluding: taxes, facility charges and concession recovery and other pass-through fees and charges.
- b. Applicable administrative fees shall not be included on the invoice as an individual line item.
- c. All administrative fee payments shall include the contract number on any transmittal document. However, only one contract number must be entered on a transmittal document. If submitting an administrative fee payment for more than one contract, then a separate electronic payment and associated transmittal document must be submitted by the Contractor for each contract.
- d. The State will not issue an invoice for the administrative fee owed to the State. It is the responsibility of the Contractor to pay the administrative fee with no prompting from the State. Contractor shall pay the quarterly administrative fee within sixty (60) days of quarter end (refer to section below).
