This study is intended to provide an authoritative, action-oriented analysis of the composition, performance, and prospects of Nevada's key and emerging industries. The contractor will provide a set of deliverables including: full report on

The contractor will provide a set of deliverables including: full report on performance of the past State Plan for Economic Development, forward-looking analysis and recommendations regarding industry cluster and economic foundations; comprehensive analytical report and recommendations related to target industry sectors; and final strategy for target industry sector development.

What are the unique features/qualifications required for this service or good that are not available from any other vendor:

This vendor was contracted by the Secretary of State's Office in 2011 to conduct the baseline study for a state-wide economic growth agenda for Nevada. That study was utilized by GOED to develop their 5year state plan. The vendor possesses the proven expertise, along with their knowledge of the state of Nevada at the local and state level, that will allow them to thoroughly review the state through the lens

4 It is imperative to have continuity between the baseline study and the new study. Contracting with the same vendor will help with the long-term view and will be more efficient as the new study becomes a 2.0 version of the original plan vs. starting from scratch. The agency anticipates receiving another quality study that will be used to move Nevada forward in diversifying and strengthening the state's economy.
